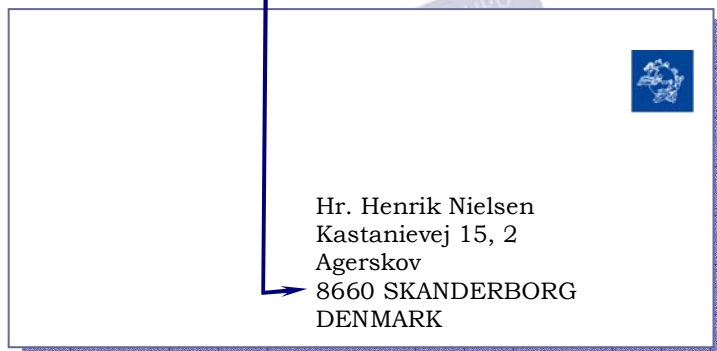
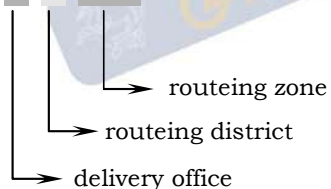
Postcode

Postcode type and position

4 digits to the left of the locality name.

Coding method

8 6 6 0



Address format

- The address consists of a maximum of seven lines (eight for international mail).
- Each line should not contain more than 54 characters and spaces.
- The lines of the address are justified to the left.
- There should be no extra spaces between characters or words. There should, however, be two spaces between the postcode and name of the town.
- There should be no extra spaces between two address lines.
- It is recommended that no part of the address be underlined.

Correct addressing

- 1 Customer number, if available.
- 2 Civil status and name of addressee.
- 3 For the attention of (+ name), if necessary.
- 4 Thoroughfare, number and floor, if available.
- 5 Further location details, if necessary.
- 6 P.O. Box and number, if necessary.
- 7 Postcode, one or two spaces and town (delivery office).
